INDIAN RED BRICKS

Indian red bricks, often simply called “red bricks,” are a quintessential building material with a rich history and widespread use across India. They are typically made from a mixture of clay, sand, and water, which is then molded into rectangular blocks and fired in kilns at high temperatures. The distinct reddish-brown color comes from the iron content in the clay, which oxidizes during the firing process



Characteristics:

Color: The most defining feature is their earthy red to reddish-brown hue, which can vary slightly depending on the local clay composition.

Texture: They usually have a somewhat rough and porous texture, contributing to their traditional aesthetic.


Durability: When properly fired, red bricks are highly durable, resistant to weathering, and have excellent compressive strength, making them suitable for load-bearing walls.





YELLOW BRICKS


Indian yellow bricks are a traditional building material known for their distinctive warm hue, ranging from pale ochre to deep mustard, derived from iron oxide-rich clay.
